Ingun Fornes is an associate professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Bergen and researcher at The Regional Centre for Research and Education in Forensic Psychiatry and Psychology, Haukeland University Hospital of Bergen, Norway. Her research primarily focus on children in conflict with the law. She has published journal articles and book chapters in the fields of criminal law, criminal procedure, execution of sentences and restorative justice. Fornes has particularly concentrated on the use of imprisonment and alternatives to it for children, providing insights into how the justice system can be better adapted to this vulnerable group. She is currently involved in a five-year interdisciplinary research project on assessments of children’s criminal insanity and violence risk.
