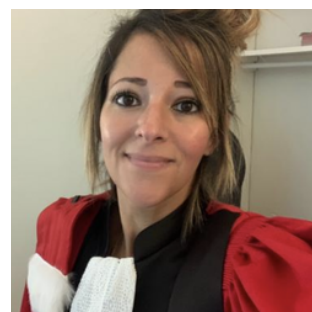

Nadia Beddiar is professor of public law at the Catholic University of Lille and member of the C3RD research center. She runs the university diploma ‘Children's rights and best interests’.

Her thesis was devoted to the juvenile offenders in prison, and her Ability to Supervise Researches (French certification qualifying holder to be university professor) is focused on the children's rights, in particular the question of respect for their fundamental rights during institutional placement. Her current research focuses on children and the criminal justice system. She is involved in a number of research projects and is currently directing work on the effects of the new juvenile criminal justice code. Her lessons focuses exclusively on children's rights in France and in an international perspective.
