Tea Machaidze is a Child Protection Officer at the UN Office of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General on Violence against Children (OSRSG VAC), Tea supports global efforts to end violence against children (VAC), with a particular focus on the prevention of and response to VAC within the justice systems, promoting child-friendly justice systems, and preventing and combatting child trafficking and gender-based violence (GBV). Tea Machaidze’s work spans advocacy, policy development, and program management at both national and international levels.

Throughout her career, Tea has served on a number of international development assistance and research projects, including at UNICEF, Council of Europe (CoE), and International Development Law Organization (IDLO) and led or/and contributed to initiatives in the area of children’s and women’s rights, access to justice, and preventing and combatting violence against children and gender-based violence. With expertise in both policy and operational aspects of children's rights, she has advised governments and international/regional organizations on a range of issues including development of legal and policy frameworks, capacity building of legal professionals working with children; data collection and analysis; establishing child-friendly environment in criminal and civil justice systems, among others.
