Ms. Mama Fatima Singhateh was appointed as the UN Special Rapporteur on sale, sexual exploitation and sexual abuse of children by the UN Human Rights Council in March 2020 and serves a Global Child Protection advocate. She annually reports to the UN Human Rights Council and the Third Committee of the UN General Assembly on emerging trends and other issues of concern relating to issues that falls within the scope of her mandate.

Ms. Singhateh is a trained lawyer with over 20 years of experience and has held a number of high-level positions in public service in the Gambia. She is a former Justice Minister and has held positions as prosecutor, legislative draftsman, High Court Judge and Justice of Appeal. She has drafted laws, organized and conducted many training sessions, delivered presentations at both national and international fora and written articles and reports on many issues relating to protection and promotion of human rights, particularly on the rights of the child.
