She currently serves on the advisory board of the Born This Way Foundation, the Youth Board at State of Youth, and as a Girl Ambassador for She's the First. Anghelina has contributed to the creation of child-friendly versions of key international documents, including the Universal Declaration of Human Rights 75: Children's Vision for Human Rights and General Comment No. 26.

As a speaker, she has brought the voices of marginalized children to global platforms such as TEDx, Amnesty International, Plan International, and the United Nations Headquarters, advocating for a world where the lived experiences of young people affected by rights violations become the foundation for systemic change.

Currently based in Madrid, Anghelina studies at The Global College while continuing to collaborate with organizations and youth movements around the world. She firmly believes that meaningful change is only possible when children are no longer left out of decision-making - and she is always open to partnerships that advance this mission.
